The COVID-19 pandemic has placed unprecedented strain on health systems, testing them to and beyond their limits. This crisis has prompted those who design and govern healthcare systems to ask important questions around what could have been done differently to prepare for the crisis and how we can change health systems to make them more resilient to future crises and sustainable in the face of long-term pressures. This hybrid event will bring together global leaders, innovators, academics, policymakers, patients and healthcare professionals to explore what we need to do now in order to strengthen health systems and so this pandemic would hopefully trigger positive change for the future.

Meeting objectives:

- **Improve the understanding of challenges and opportunities for health systems** moving forward, taking account of systems-relevant learnings from the ongoing COVID pandemic and previous crises
- **Continue to convene and build a community of interest** in building systems-level health resilience and sustainability, composed of national and international experts, policy makers and private sector partners willing to learn and act together
- **Catalyse action** to improve the resilience of health systems

In the pursuit of these objectives, insights and networks created by the Partnership for Health System Sustainability and Resilience (PHSSR), a public-private-academic partnership formed in 2020 and now present in >20 countries globally, will be leveraged.

The Summit agenda has four areas of focus:

- **Expert Session 1: Raising the effectiveness of care by acting early on chronic diseases** – a key theme for ageing populations across the globe, this session looks at the opportunities (e.g. new technologies and know-how) and the actions required to succeed in addressing the increasingly unsustainable social and economic costs caused by chronic diseases
- **Expert Session 2: Optimising the location where care is provided to patients** – learning from the progress seen in the last two years during the pandemic, this session investigates where and how care pathway redesign and digital innovations can improve patient care, reduce hospitalisations and improve systems resilience to health shocks
- **Keynote Session: Building more resilient and sustainable health systems for the future** – in which global leaders from politics, health services, academia and the private sector will elaborate on key features of resilient and sustainable health systems, look back to learn from prior crises and look forward to the journey ahead in creating stronger health systems in a globally connected world
- **PHSSR Global Expansion Launch Event** – celebrating the impact the Partnership for Health System Sustainability and Resilience has had to date in creating actionable insights how to strengthen health systems post the COVID pandemic. Key members of the PHSSR as well as important researchers and stakeholders from participating countries will share their insights and reflections.
