Welcome Message from the Chair of CAPRI

Welcome to CAPRI's second Annual Forum, "Changing Currents: Innovation and Transformation for the Asia Pacific." I am delighted that so many of you are able to join us in Taipei for a fruitful exchange of ideas covering some of the region's most pressing issues. I wish to thank all of our partners who have supported the program today: CAPRI USA, the National Bureau of Asian Research, the Partnership for Health System Sustainability and Resilience, Nikkei Asia, and CommonWealth Magazine.

Featured Research Partners at the 2024 Annual Forum

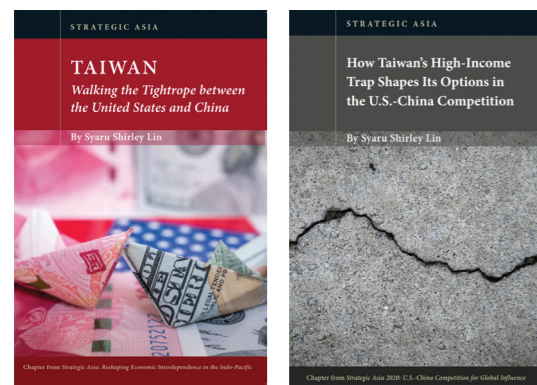
Our research focuses on the most pressing challenges to resilience at the intersection of health, economy, environmental sustainability, and technology, particularly in high-income societies.

我們的研究重點涵蓋公衛、經濟、環境永續和科技，尤其是高收入社會下相互交織的議題以因應挑戰，提升全球韌性。



CAPRI has collaborated with the National Bureau of Asian Research (NBR) on its flagship publication *Strategic Asia*. In 2023, Syaru Shirley Lin contributed the chapter "Taiwan: Walking the Tightrope between the United States and China," investigating the implications of US-China decoupling for Taiwan's economy. In 2020, Prof. Lin analyzed Taiwan's double bind of trying to preserve its identity against increasing Chinese pressure while integrating with the Chinese market to address the severe socioeconomic problems of Taiwan's high-income trap—encompassing wage stagnation, increasing living costs, energy insecurity, and political polarization.

亞堅會與美國國家亞洲研究局 (NBR) 合作出版了該局的旗艦出版物《戰略亞洲》(Strategic Asia)。2023 年，林夏如教授撰寫了《台灣：走在美中之間的鋼索上》這一章，研究了中美脫鉤對台灣經濟的影響。2020 年，林教授在其《台灣的高收入陷阱如何在美中競爭中影響其選擇》一章中，分析了台灣的雙重束縛。即台灣試圖保持其身份以對抗中國日益增長的壓力，同時與中國市場整合以解決台灣高收入陷阱的嚴重社經問題—包括工資停滯、生活成本上升、能源維安和政治兩極化。



CAPRI is a founding member and the first regional research hub of the Partnership for Health System Sustainability and Resilience (PHSSR), whose goal is to improve global health by building more sustainable and resilient health systems. PHSSR member organizations include the London School of Economics, the WHO Foundation, the World Economic Forum, AstraZeneca, KPMG, Philips, CAPRI, and additional organizations at the regional and national levels. CAPRI is leading research on the health systems of the Asia Pacific with its Senior Fellows, with reports on Malaysia, South Korea, Taiwan, the Marshall Islands, Tonga, and Vanuatu.

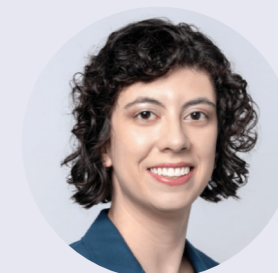
